

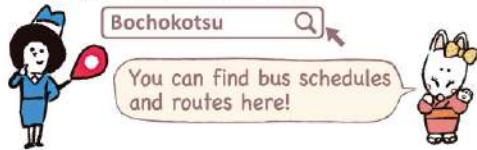

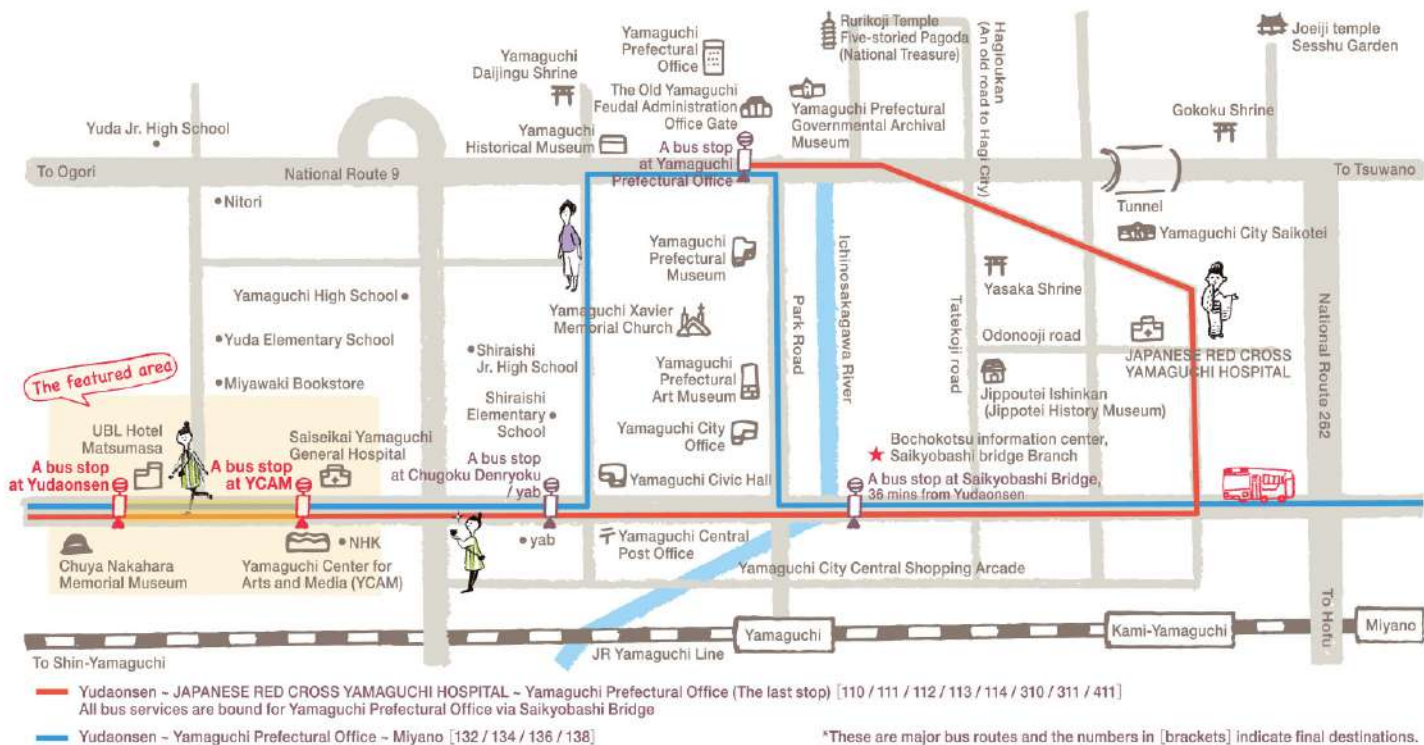

A Ryokan hotel visited by important historical figures of the Meiji restoration



A long established "Matsudaya Hotel" with about 340 years of history has been well-known as a place where important historical figures gathered for the Meiji restoration. There is "the Meiji Restoration Museum" with important archives from the period in the hotel. Please make a reservation to visit the museum in advance.

A white fox legend in Yudaonsen

There is a legend about Yudaonsen's hot spring, that 800 years ago an injured white fox discovered the spring and treated his wounded leg with the healing hot water. In association with the legend, there are numerous appearances of foxes in variety forms throughout the Yudaonsen Spa area. Take a walk and look for them!

3 Inoue Park

A park made at a birthplace of Kaoru Inoue, an elder statesman in the Meiji period. This park has many tourist interests such as a bronze statue of Kaoru Inoue, a monument for seven historical patriots from the late Edo period, and Kaentei, a replicated house used for a conspiracy meeting in the period.

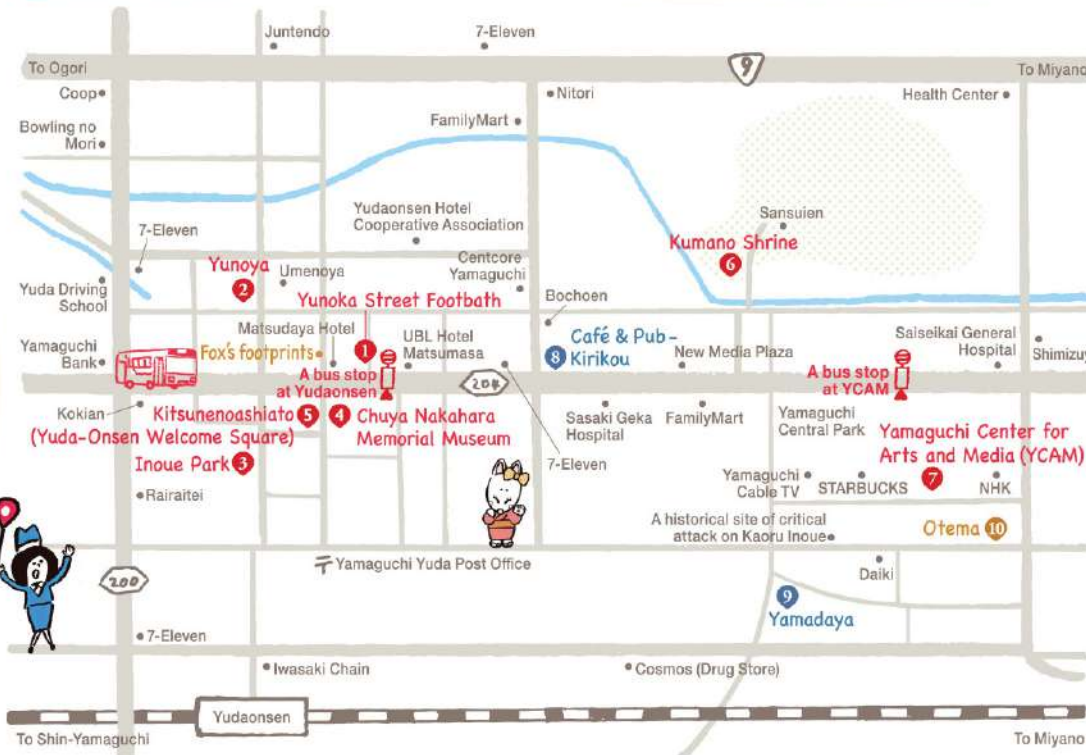
